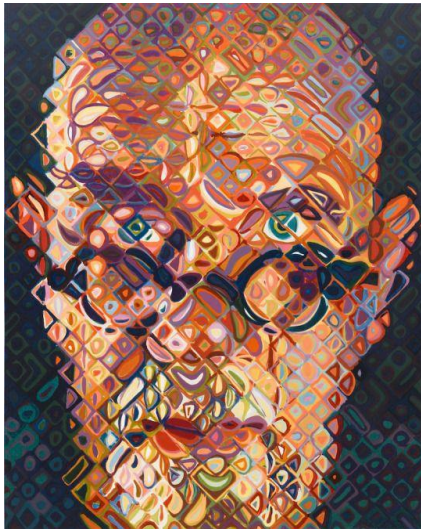

This might involve a portrait or objects which are important to you.

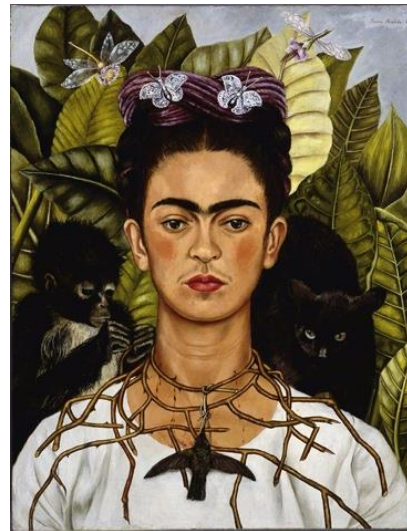
You will learn how to make a piece of art from this starting point and how to plan it in your sketchbook GCSE style.

- **Painting technique**, using **light and shade**.
- **Print technique** using **relief and colour overlay**
- **Clay technique** using **modelling**
